MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This Memorandum of understanding is entered into between the

- (1) Engineering Council of India, and its Member Associations, having its registered Office at 1304, Hemkunt Chambers, 89, Nehru Place, New Delhi 110 019 (hereinafter called "ECI" or "First Party" which expression shall where the context so admits include its successors and permitted assignees), and
- (2) Centre for Electronic Governance, Rajasthan, having its registered Office at Near Govt. R.C. Khaitan Polytechnic College, Jhalana Doongri, Jaipur 302004 (hereinafter called "CEG" or "Second Party" which expression shall where the context so admits include its successors and permitted assignees)

WHEREAS, ECI is registered as a Not–for-profit Society under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and is the prime institution to standardize and harmonize, in various major engineering disciplines, professional practices in India and competency standards of practicing professionals with their counterparts in other member countries of WTO, having among their founding board members Planning Commission (Now NITI Aayog), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), National Board of Accreditation (NBA), Central Public Works Department (Ministry of Urban Development), Department of Commerce (Ministry of Commerce & Industry), Dept. of Secondary and Higher Education (Ministry of HRD), Department of Scientific and Industrial Research, Council of Scientific & Industrial Research & several other Professional Institutions.

ECI works together with its Members and other associate organizations to fulfill the objects laid down by ECI. Any agreement / MoU of any entity with ECI will be subject to the provision that the operations involved in the said Agreement / MoU may be carried out by one or more of its members /associates. The nomination of such a member / associate is the sole prerogative of ECI. For this purpose, ECI may like to consult the parties with whom Agreement / MoU is signed.

Whereas CEG is an autonomous body of Government of Rajasthan under the Department of Technical Education. CEG has been established with a sole aim to provide an excellent environment for creating industry employable IT professionals by the way of arranging seminars lectures, vocational training, and industry relevant software training. At the same time provides a readymade platform interaction between the industry and the trained workforce.

Scope and objectives:

CEG is desirous of facilitating employment to the learners of technical streams from various Universities and institutes of Rajasthan state and ECI to facilitate and support CEG to achieve this objective

CEG get recognition in IT Training programs like Big data, Hadoop, AWS Cloud Computing, CCNA Trainings, ASP.NET Training, ASP.NET MVC 5 using Razor, Entity Framework, WCF, PHP, Auto CAD, Red Hat Certification training, C, C++, Linux Training program, Embedded Training programs etc. in Jaipur.

CEG is authorized education partner of CISCO. Training programs run at CEG are approved by Rajasthan Technical education. CEG is also working as study Centre of IGNOU for MCA, BCA, CIT, PGDIS and ACISE programs. CEG started software development and Live Project training to give exposure to real-time applications to students.CEG also Conduct Summer Training programs for M.Sc., B.Tech, M.Tech and Diploma students. Our training programs are industrial oriented and syllabus is specially designed to fulfill requirements of industry work. We provide 6 Months MCA Industrial Oriented Training, B.Tech. Summer Training, Diploma students training etc.

Both the entities would work to make the Information Technology Training Programs popular in India. This Memorandum of Understanding aims to have a tie up in all aspects of IT Training as detailed below:

Responsibilities:-

First Party:-

- 1) To impart hands on training and grooming the learners under ECI- AICTE Internship scheme.
- 2) To generate Internship and thus placement opportunities with Industry using the network of their member associations.
- 3) To help the Institutions to develop the on campus facilities to impart such training and also develop a cadre of competent instructors to operate such systems independently using only the intellectual patronage of ECI.
- 4) To help CEG to develop a database of trained and certified personnel for wider use by the prospective employers.
- 5) To support CEG in organization of sensitization seminars, conferences, and workshops.
- 6) To train and groom placement/HR staff of the Institutions in Rajasthan and to establish a coordination.
- To bear expenditures of TA/DA/ honorariums for conducting trainings / Placement assistance based on self financing scheme.

Second Party:-

- 1) To issue necessary directives/ advisories to the Institutions offering technical education.
- 2) To interact with other departments of GOR and ensure issuance of such directives/advisories as may be needed and to constitute high powered working groups to deal with any exigent issue required to be acted upon in fulfillment of the objectives.
- To organize sensitization seminars, workshops and conferences with active and financial support of ECI.
- 4) To provide require support related to physical infrastructure in the context of conduct of the program covered under the scope of this MoU for proper coordination with the Ministers office and CEG.
- 5) To make available any input to ECI this may be required by them to discharge their obligations diligently.
- 6) It shall release advertisement and resort to other means of media/communication to disseminate the information about this joint initiative, periodically and when required upon the advice of ECI.

D

ECI shall be responsible to organize availing this technology, through its founder members and their member associations & All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) along with the Rajasthan Technical University (RTU) shall encourage their students & the faculty members of accredited Institutes to participate in such training.

VALIDITY

This MoU shall be further supplemented by other provisions / MoUs as may be required from time to time. The MOU shall be valid, initially for a period of five years, extendable by mutual consent.

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:

The Parties shall use their best efforts to settle amicably all disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement or the interpretation thereof. If any dispute, difference, question or disagreement arises between the Parties hereto or their respective representatives or assignees, in connection with construction, meaning operation, effect interpretation of the Agreement or breach thereof which Parties are unable to settle mutually within 30 days from the commencement of settlement proceedings and if not settled than the same shall be referred to the court.

TERMINATION

This MoU could be terminated by giving a notice of one year or the conclusion of ongoing programs, whichever is later, from either side.
